

ERC-East 2012 - 2015 Vision, Goals & Activities

1. The Vision, Goals and Activities of ERC-East, the emergency communications umbrella for LDS emergency communications in the Eastern US and Canada, in order of importance are to:
 - A. Provide oversight, guidance, training, feedback and encouragement to emergency communication specialists / net managers in the performance of their duties to bring improvement in the organization, protocols, procedures and operations of the Church emergency communications networks.
 - B. Provide guidance to emergency communication operators and priesthood leaders during training exercises and disaster response.
 - C. Use priesthood organization and leadership principles, connecting the emergency communication network resources to the appropriate storehouse and priesthood leaders in order to provide accurate, timely and complete information during disasters.
 - D. Provide the maximum support possible for the Northeast and Southeast areas EmComm goals, activities and efforts.
 - E. Encourage the Northeast and Southeast areas to have a minimum of 30% of Amateur Radio Operators who own radios to become ERC-East EmComm Level I qualified.
 - F. Encourage each ERC net in the ERC-East boundaries to have a minimum of ten qualified and trained net control stations for sustained VHF and HF operations.
 - G. Encourage ERC net in the ERC-East boundaries to encourage stakes to hold meaningful weekly nets, Technician Classes, exercises and annual meetings.
 - H. Check in weekly, with the both the Northeast and Southeast area nets and forwarding their reports to the Church headquarters leadership.
